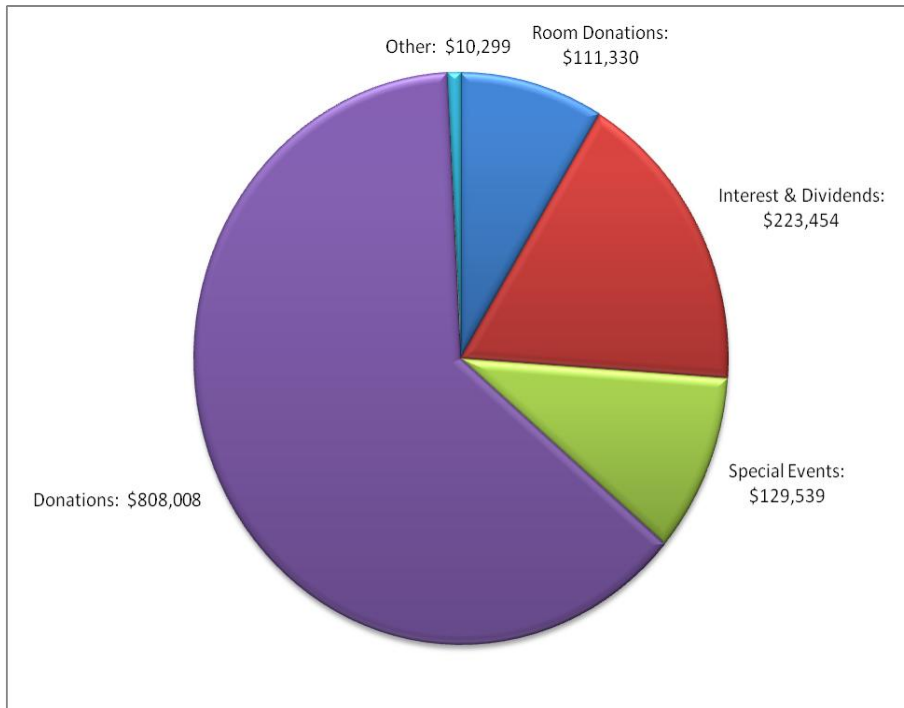
### Major Program Areas

Ronald McDonald House: Ronald McDonald House of Rochester, Minnesota supports the wellbeing of children and families seeking specialized pediatric medical care in Rochester, Minnesota. The House primarily serves Mayo Clinic patients who travel across the United States and the world. A 42 bedroom home provides bedrooms and shared living areas. In 2008, we served 1,065 families, yet 626 were turned away. The need for services and accommodations at the Ronald McDonald House exceeds our current capacity. In order to turn away fewer families, the organization is positioning for growth.

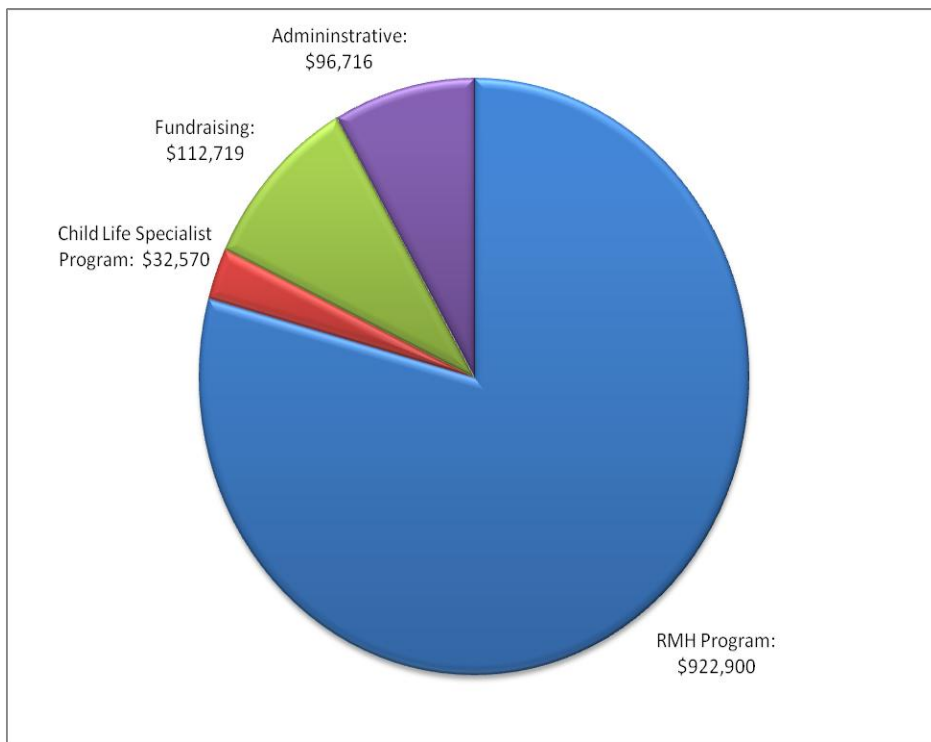
