Supplies needed:

- Fabric
- Scissors
- Duct tape
- Ruler
- Stapler & staples
- Belting (for handle)
- Iron

No-Sew Pillowcase Tote Bag: *(pillowcase must be new)



Supplies needed:

- King size pillowcase
- Rope or thick, braided fabric
- Small fabric strips to use for ties
- Scissors
- Masking tape
